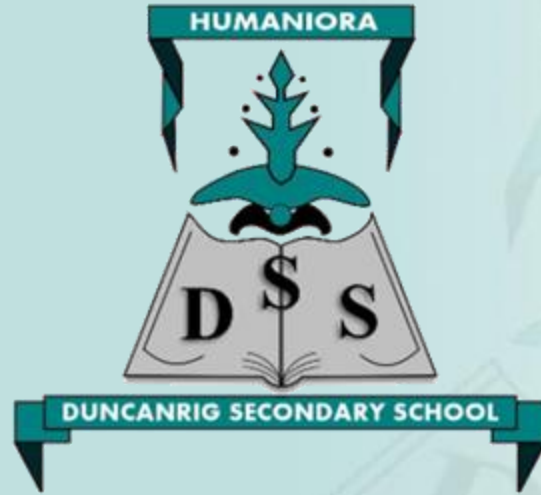
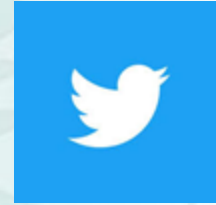

A project to get rid of single-use plastic bottles in Duncanrig.



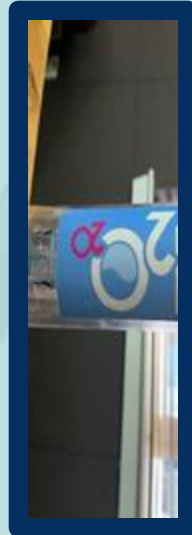
Wan Use is Nae Use
